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Dear Colleagues,

We are glad to inform you that the preparation stage of WEEM-2026 has passed successfully, in particular the payment of the accommodation fees to the hotel. The 3rd circular is to provide you with various useful information on WEEM-2026.

This information has been prepared for you in the form of *files* which are *cited below*.

Since the transfer of attached files via email is *blocked* by email servers of some participants *all these files are available via internet site*: <https://disk.yandex.ru/d/HszFqrveFjpTLg> inside directory: "**WEEM-2026**".

The information on the participants *arriving via the Venice airport on May 24 morning* and having *booked seats in the WEEM bus* is given in file: **Arrivals+WEEM bus on May 24 via airport.doc** while the one on the participants arrived earlier (who have also booked seats in the WEEM bus *from the Mestre station*) may be found in file: **Arrivals+WEEM bus on May 24 via Mestre.doc**.

Please check once again all this information concerning each of you.

Detailed information on *the meeting points at the Mestre railway station and at the Venice airport* is given in file: **Travel information on WEEM buses on May 24 and on May 29.doc**.

It is recommended for each participant to copy this file in order to use this information in the way.

Please decide *beforehand* which communications means you prefer to use in the way. It will be extremely important to ensure that *all participants planning to use the WEEM bus will be in time at the corresponding meeting point*.

Please take into account the information on the *expected weather in the way and within the conference period* provided by the hotel via LOC.

For May 23 and 24 the meteo predictions give for Venice the temperature on the level of about 25 while those on the sunny or rainy weather change each day.

The participants who plan *to visit the historical center of Venezia* should look through the website: <https://cda.ve.it/en/> for the information concerning *local taxes* introduced recently which should be paid within *red days of the calendar*. Exemptions are given for those who have already paid local Tourist tax for the accommodation in this area.

Typically the weather in Bellamonte is changeable in the period of the conference. One should expect a mixture of sun and clouds with a high likelihood of rain, as May is typically one of the wetter months in this part of the Dolomites. Bellamonte forecast shows daily high temperatures ranging from 4.7° to 18.8° Celsius, with overnight lows between -2.5° and 9.3°. The average high for May is 15° with an average low of 6°. It is recommended to bring layers, including a warm sweater or fleece, a waterproof jacket, and sturdy shoes for potential wet hiking trails.

As for the main hotel facilities, one can find the information of the hotel's websites: www.hotelsancelso.com and www.hotelstellaalpinabellamonte.it. Other relevant information regarding the various activities will be provided either on Sunday, May 24, 2026, at the registration desk or on Monday morning before the conference opening.

The scientific program of WEEM-2026 includes about 50 oral and poster presentations. Their abstracts (either extended ones or those submitted inside Application Forms) *will be available inside the Conference Proceedings* which are now under preparation.

The list of all presentations may be found inside file: **List of authors for Conference booklet.doc** where the authors are grouped inside three chapters: keynote, oral and poster presentations, with alphabetic order within each chapter. All these abstracts are actually available inside the same directory: "**WEEM-2026**".

The timetable of various events in the course of WEEM-2026 may be found in file: **Timetable_WEEM-2026_PROJECT_2026-05-16.doc**. There may be further changes in the Timetable, e.g. slight shifts of the period of lunches and dinners some days. The time interval of coffee-break will not be fixed beforehand since

it may be slightly shifted by chairs of the session, adjusting it to the needs of discussions in the course of the session (without changing its duration: 30 minutes)

A preliminary program of *oral* sessions may be found in file: **Program of oral sessions_2026-05-16.doc** . Unfortunately, the arrival of some participants is not guaranteed by the moment which can result in its change. You'll be able to find corrected versions of the program at the same internet site later.

Attention of the authors of *oral* presentations:

Each of you has been informed on the *duration of your monologue exposition (20 min. for a keynote presentation, 15 min. for all oral ones)* The session's chairs will be instructed to terminate it after this time has been elapsed. The goal is to leave the maximum time for questions, (critical) comments and discussions which may be related not only to exposed results but also to other questions of interest in the area. Both the lecturer and a participant formulating a question/comment are strongly invited to answer clearly but with keeping in mind the economy of the discussion time, especially if there are many listeners who want to participate in this discussion.

All oral presentations (in PPT format) should be uploaded into the conference computer before the beginning of the corresponding session. If a lecturer does not want to transfer his/her PPT file to the conference computer the time spent for attachment of his own computer to the projector will be counted as a part of his presentation time.

Poster presentations:

Standard *poster exposition* sessions are planned for Tuesday and Thursday evening (see Timetable) where the participants can meet the authors of poster presentation at their stands/panels/boards.

For this demonstration the posters should be properly prepared. Poster boards are designed for vertical format posters (portrait orientation) with dimensions of 75 cm width × 100 cm height.

Materials for mounting the posters will be provided on site.

All posters may be mounted from Monday morning and will remain on display for the entire duration of the workshop. Posters should be removed after the second poster session on Thursday evening.

Poster boards will be labeled with the corresponding poster numbers as listed in the electronic conference proceedings, i.e. in the order given in file: **List of authors for Conference booklet.doc**.

A specific feature of WEEM conferences is in the *Oral Poster sessions* which is planned for Monday evening. It is carried out *in the hall for oral sessions*, without a need for posters already mounted at poster boards. It is performed as a *conventional oral session* with the use of a projector and a screen while the *duration of each talk of a poster author is three minutes*, without questions and comments from the audience after the presentation.

Its goal is to give a *brief advertisement of the content of the poster* via emphasizing the most interesting results of your study (without their substantiation!) in order to draw attention of participants to your poster during the *poster expositions* on Tuesday and Thursday evenings.

The authors interested in this opportunity should prepare the corresponding PPT file which starts from a formal slide (containing the title of the presentation, its author(s) and affiliation(s), without any other information) followed by one or two slides illustrating your talk.

In view of the time limitations for this session these PPT files of all the three-minute presentations must be gathered beforehand into a global PPT file for the whole poster session. For inclusion of your PPT file it is strongly advised to send it (at least on May 21) as attached file to the addresses:

If it is not possible you can also transfer your PPT file to the organizer of the Oral Poster Session (Prof. Oleg Levin) in the course your Registration on May 24 via the local organizers. It would be dangerous to postpone this transfer until Monday, May 25.

By the moment 10 poster authors have announced their intention to participate in this session. Their list may be given in file: **ORAL POSTER SESSION_list of presentations_2026-05-17.doc**

The authors are invited to check the correctness of the names and titles.

The other poster authors are welcome both as listeners and as reporters (then, these authors should send the application request as soon as possible via email: mivo2010@yandex.com).
